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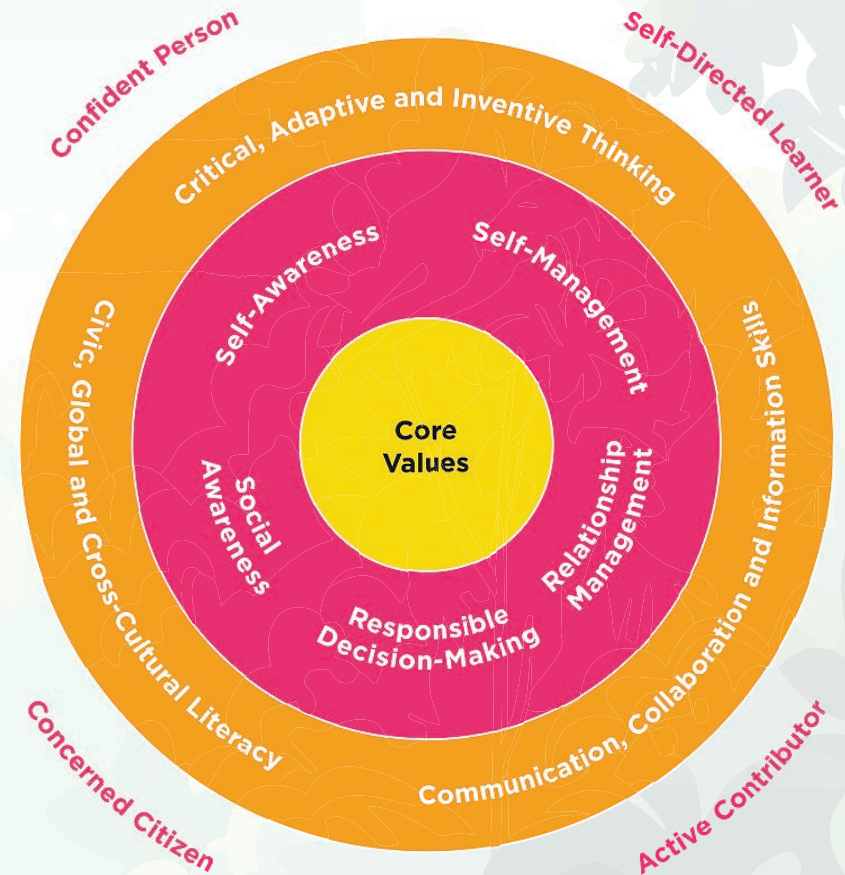
Programme Design Principles & Learning Outcomes

Wildlife Buddies (For Schools)

Students develop animal-themed activities and take on the role of buddies to engage their chosen beneficiaries. This self-directed learning opportunity helps to foster empathy and hone project management, collaborative and communication skills.

Participants gain social experience and confidence as they step out of their comfort zone to engage our guests and inspire them to care for wildlife. This volunteer opportunity enhances civic and global literacy and foster self-management.

Recruitment happens quarterly across different parks.
